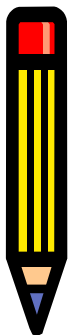
A TYPICAL DAILY SESSION shall provide students with many of the following which include a...

Students attending camp should...

- Be dropped off at the above location a couple minutes prior to their session and must be picked up immediately following their assigned time unless other arrangements have been made.
- Wear old clothing that will not be harmed by creative occurrences.
- Be prepared to have a lot of fun.
